**RUNNING FOXES BEGINS SEVEN WELL DRILLING PROGRAM AT THE SAZUEK
NORTHEAST, TATE AND RUSK FIELDS IN SUMNER COUNTY, KANSAS.**

Centennial, Colorado, April 11th, 2011: Running Foxes Petroleum Inc. ("RFPI") is pleased to announce that they have just drilled and run pipe on its third well in its seven well program at the Sazuek Northeast Field. The Company has been producing from four wells completed in the Mississippian "Chat" since 2008.

The AO 3-7-2 has been re-entered and pipe has been run. The well has 28 feet of Mississippian Chat of which nine feet is potential pay. The AO 4-7-3 has been drilled and pipe has been run. The Mississippian Chat was 69 feet thick of which 12 feet is potentially productive.

The Franklin 14-6-2 has reached total and encountered 29 feet of Mississippian Chat with approximately 10 to 12 feet of potential pay. Pipe has been run.

The drill rig is moving to the Andra 8-12-3 followed by the White 9-12-2 which form the southeast extension of the Sazuek Northeast Field. These two wells offset wells plugged in the mid-1980s due to low oil prices that were doing 20 to 40 BOPD at the time.

The Ruyle 11-13-1 will be drilled to re-open the Tate Field that originally produced from the Simpson Sand. The Schlichting 7-8-4 will be drilled to re-open the Rusk Field which produced over 375MBO from the Simpson Sand.

The Sedgwick Basin has been producing gas from Arbuckle, Simpson, Viola, Mississippian Chat and multiple Pennsylvanian pays since before 1960. The primary pay in the basin is the Mississippian Chat. The depth to basement is less than 5,000 feet.
